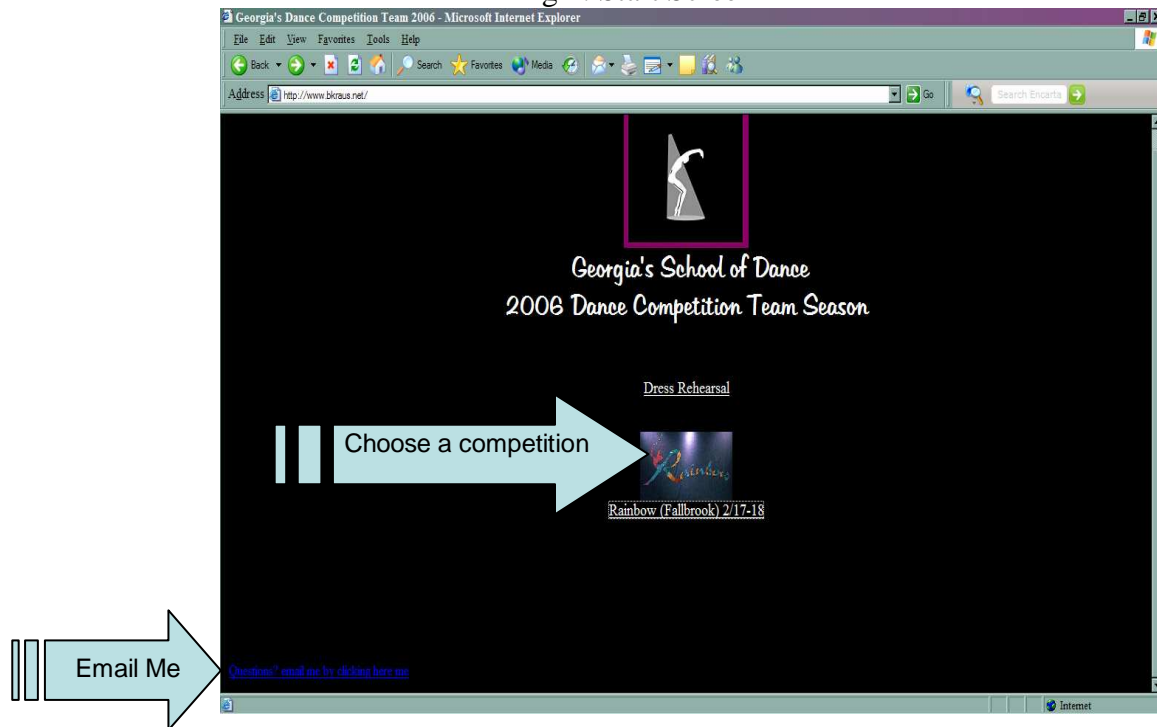


Welcome to Georgia's School of Dance 2006 Dance Competition Team Season.

This will be my attempt to help you navigate the site. If you have additional questions please catch me at the studio or email me by clicking on the email link in the lower left hand corner of the start page (Fig 1).

1. You start by choosing the competition you would like to see. Each competition will have its own link, to date there are only two.....Dress Rehearsal and Rainbow (Fallbrook) 2/17-18. Once chosen you will be taken to the Security screen...see Fig 2.

2. This is the Security Screen. If you have permission to enter this site you already know the username and password. If you do not know it check with Sue, Suzanne Kraus or me at the Studio...don't ask me via email as I cannot send it to you.

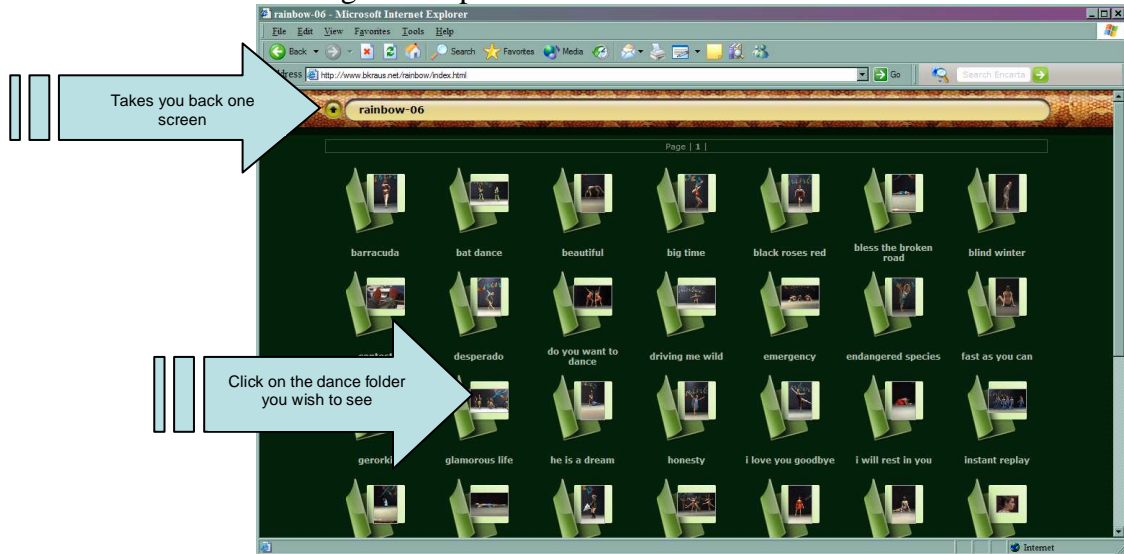
Remember.....This site is for anyone associated with the studio, their families and friends.....this page keeps everyone else away.

Fig 2. Security Screen



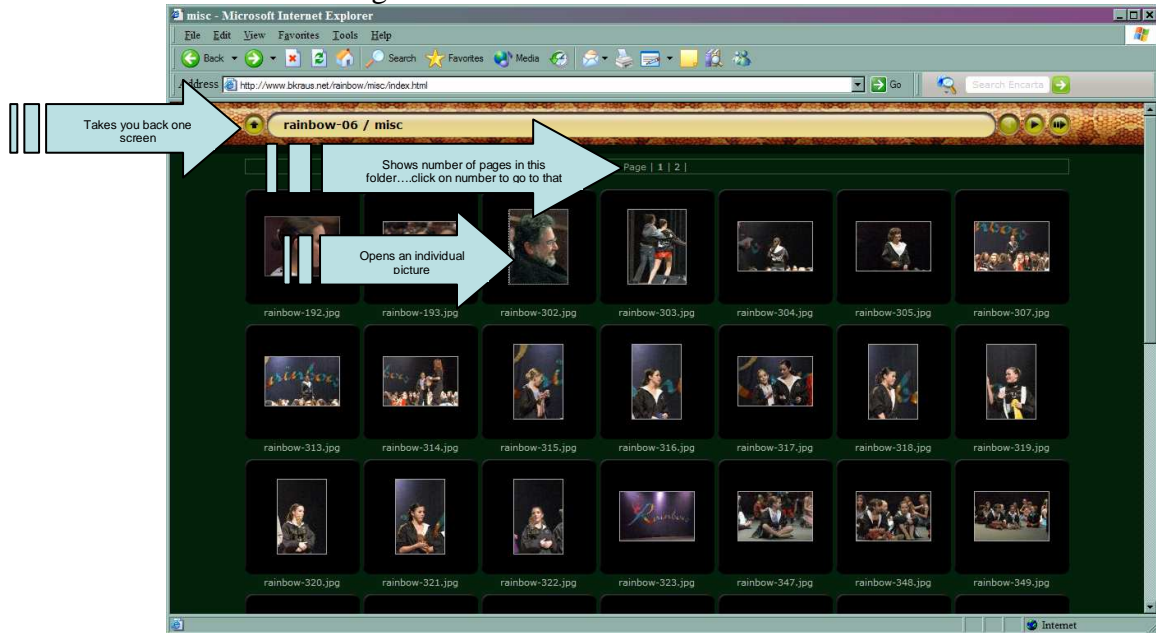
3. Once inside a competition you will find a folder for each dance by name (in alphabetical order). There will be a small picture also if you cannot remember the name but it will be very small and hard to see (Fig 3).

Fig 3. Competition Dance Folders



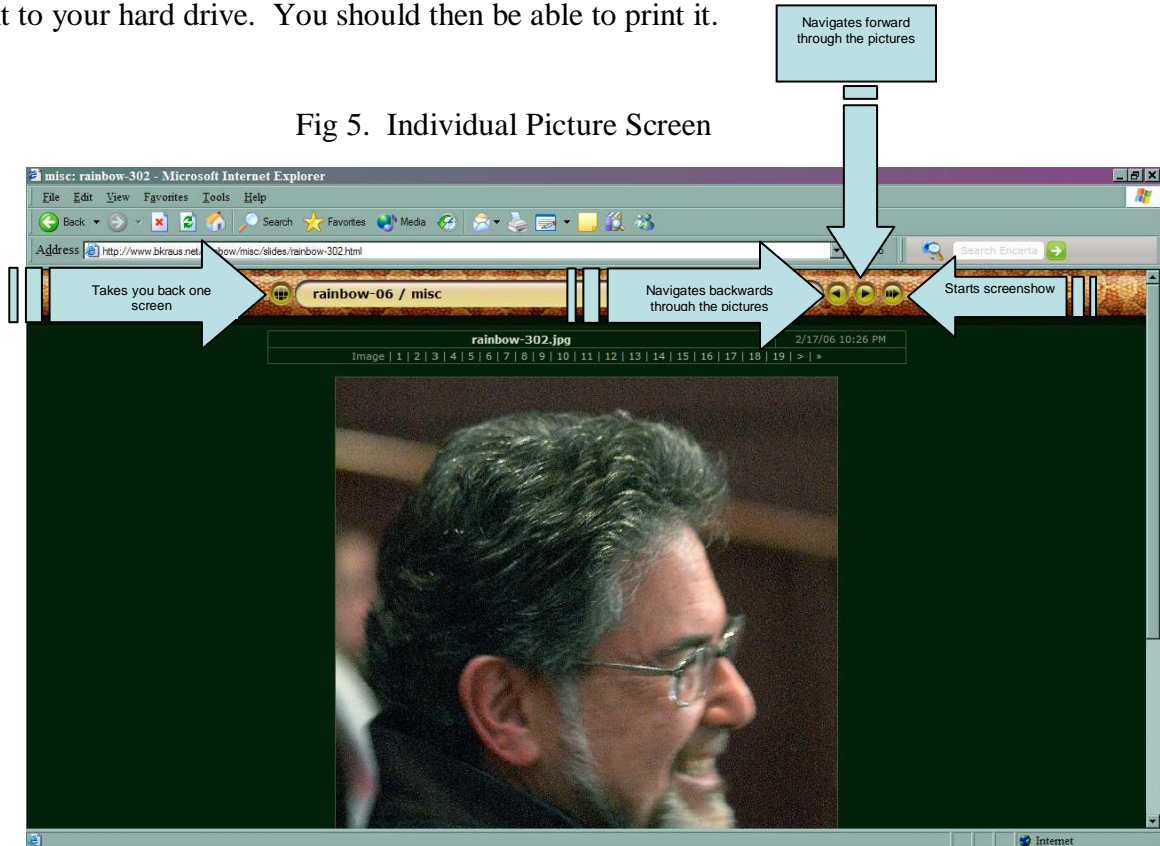
4. Once inside a dance folder (in this case I choose Misc) you will see a small version of the pictures available for that dance. Read the arrows in Fig 4, each is pointing out a navigation feature.....in this example you should learn how to go back one screen, how many pages are in this folder (clicking on the number will take you to that page), and how do view a larger version of individual pictures (click on it).

5. In the individual picture screen you get a larger view of each picture. You can navigate forward and backward using the buttons annotated in Fig 5. There is also a screenshow button....just press it and sit back, the pictures will change every 4 seconds. If you like a picture.....RIGHT CLICK it and choose the save picture as function and save it to your hard drive. You should then be able to print it.
